Dear Parents,

The school is pleased to commence the Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) Programme for the Academic Year 2026–27. These activities are designed to promote the holistic development of students by identifying and nurturing their talents, skills, creativity, and physical well-being in line with the implementation of skill development in school at various levels.

Duration of programme : Eight Months (July 2026 to February 2027)

Grades : I – VIII

Day : Tuesdays

Duration : 2 hours along with regular classes.

General Guidelines:

1. Each activity requires a minimum number of enrolments. If the required number of participants are not met, the activity may be cancelled, and the student may be asked to opt for another available activity.
2. The day and timing of activities may be altered based on the convenience of the school.
3. Participation in at least one co-curricular activity is compulsory for all students as part of the school's commitment to skill development and the overall growth of every child.
4. Parents are encouraged to help their children maintain continuity in the same activity across academic years, especially in activities that are structured into different levels. Consistent participation enables students to develop greater interest, proficiency, confidence, and mastery in their chosen activity.
5. Regular practice of the chosen activity, both during the scheduled CCA sessions and after school hours alongside regular academics, will help students develop continuity, sustain interest, and achieve greater proficiency and mastery of the skill over time.
6. Students are responsible for taking proper care of all equipment, instruments, uniforms, and gears related to their chosen activity. The school will not be responsible for loss or damage caused due to negligence or improper handling by students.



7. Wherever specific uniforms, costumes, instruments, or activity-related gears are required, the purchase and use of the same is mandatory to ensure proper participation and continuity in the activity.
8. All purchases related to CCA activities must be made only through the process and channels communicated by the school. Parents and students are advised not to engage in any direct financial transactions or individual arrangements with CCA instructors. The school will not be responsible for any disputes, complaints, non-delivery of items, or other concerns arising from payments or dealings made directly with CCA instructors.
9. Parents and students are requested to cooperate with the school and the CCA instructors in ensuring that the required items are available for effective participation.
10. Students must maintain discipline, punctuality, and respectful behaviour during CCA sessions. The CCA instructors must be treated with due respect, and students are expected to follow the instructions and guidelines provided by them.
11. For any queries, concerns, or issues related to CCA activities, parents and students must communicate only through the designated school coordinators/teachers assigned for CCA matters.

12. The duly filled consent form along with the prescribed CCA fee must be submitted to the Class Teacher on or before 24 June, 2026.
13. The fee once paid for the selected activity will be non-refundable and non-transferable under any circumstances.
14. Parents are advised to avoid switching activities during the middle of an academic year, as continuity and consistent practice in a chosen activity help students develop interest, skill, confidence, and proficiency in their area of learning.
15. If a student wishes to switch from one CCA activity to another, a **formal written request from the parent** must be submitted to the school office. Such requests will be considered **only on a case-by-case basis** and approval will be granted only under genuine circumstances, such as health-related reasons or other valid concerns.
16. In case the student opts for an activity with a **higher fee**, the difference in fee amount must be paid by the parent.

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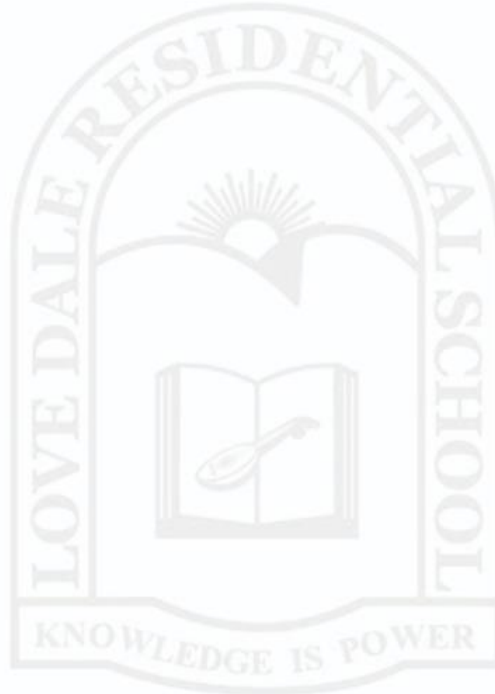
